Landscaping Crew: 4 person landscape crew on site for weekly horticultural maintenance.





Facilities Maintenance

Completed projects (2021)

- Replace flushometers throughout venue and parkland RR's- original flushometers not compatible w/ reclaimed water.
- FCU's (fan coil units) in venue condensation pump filters clogged- Disassembled, cleaned and reassembled units
- Installed temporary Skate stops on stair railing around park to deter skateboarders from damaging park property.
- Installed door stops throughout venue

- Repaired irrigation at Symphony Square system was disconnected during freeze/snow event in February 2021
- Replaced all faucets @ parkland restroom area sink.
 original faucets not durable enough to stand up to public use
- Installed temporary sewer vent line in loading dock area @ Amphitheater to reroute sewer gases. Also pumped out grease trap



Facilities Maintenance

Open Projects

- Loading Dock roll down gate repair Gate was damaged during Creek Show in November and we are awaiting replacement parts
- Install trash/recycle compactor (due to be installed Feb. 1, 2022)
- Adjust parkland restroom gate difficult to operate and needs modifications to design.
- Address multiple electrical issues w/ Alterman throughout park and venue - from lighting to in-ground power issues, to breaker issues, etc.

- Ongoing irrigation repair and adjustments repair irrigation lines, heads, valves, etc., as necessary due to normal wear and tear, vandalism, incidental damage due to events, landscape maintenance, etc.
- Elevator door control install keypad/key control to limit access into box office/security area within venue building.



Facilities Maintenance

Upcoming Projects (2022)

- Inspect, maintain playground equipment and EWF will coordinate with PARD on this item. Fluff and/or add to or replace EWF as necessary
- Label irrigation, electrical and any other types of in-ground control boxes throughout the venue/parkland

- Develop a more robust preventive maintenance program for park and venue systems.
- Reconcile expiring warranties and replace with service maintenance contracts.



Horticulture

Completed Projects (2021)

- Tree Uplift pruning, ball moss removal and old light removal completed in Aug 2021. Work was coordinated and supervised by PARD Forestry.
- Fire Ant Treatment worked with Cleanscapes to apply PARD IPM approved treatments at affected areas throughout the park.

Horticulture

Upcoming Projects (2022)

- Topdressing and aerification of lawns using cleanscapes to perform the annual application of topsoil and aerification of lawns to maintain the health and vitality of the grass. Work scheduled for Jan 24 - Feb 22
- Cut back of native grasses annual maintenance of native grasses. Included in Cleanscapes contract, and will be used as an opportunity to engage volunteers

- Add stone path in Hill Country Garden building a new section of matching limestone path to resolve a high traffic desire line in the landscape
- Mulching of all landscape beds and tree rings.
- Collaborate with design team to strategically replace/replenish areas of landscape.



Ops Admin 2021 Highlights

- Opened the Park to the public on August 14, 2021!
- Onboarding and site specific training for staff and Park Ambassadors - strong emphasis on hospitality and engagement through the lenses of diversity, equity and inclusion.
- Developed curriculum for and hosted Public Space Internship. This is expected to be an annual program.
