- Life expectancy for African American men
 - is 7.1 years less than for others.
- Stroke kills 180% more African American men.
- African American men are 30% more likely
 - to die from heart disease.
- Hispanic men are more likely to have
 - diabetes and related kidney failure.
- Mental Health utilization is limited.




