### **Additional Backup Information:**

The Austin Fire Department is requesting that the City Council authorize the negotiation and execution of an interlocal agreement with the Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport Board to provide training services and permit the use of its training facility to the Austin Fire Department. The Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport Board operates a fire fighting training facility which utilizes state-of-the-art technology for live fire training and classroom training, and provides certified instructors to train qualified personnel of other agencies. This proposed interlocal agreement has a three (3) year term, effective on the date that the Agreement is fully executed and it may be terminated with 30 days written notice. The total cost of the agreement, over its 3 year term, will not exceed \$60,000.
