The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children is a preventative program that targets women and children earning below 185% of the federal poverty level. The program provides nutrition education, breastfeeding support, and nutritious foods to pregnant women, infants, and children up to age five.

Travis County desires to provide grocery shopping and delivery services to Travis County residents who receive benefits through the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children families experiencing circumstances preventing them from safely going to the grocery store in person to buy food, which will further the achievement of a public purpose.

The Women Infants and Children Program (WIC), through the Austin Public Health Department, can provide WIC families shopping and delivery services for Travis County residents who have previously received WIC benefits and are experiencing circumstances that prevent them from safely going to the grocery store in person to buy food.
