Comorbidities reported among confirmed COVID-19 case fatalities, Travis County, Texas, n= 1,282 (updated 2/7/2022)







People who reported always wearing a mask in indoor public settings were less likely to test positive for COVID-19 than people who didn't*






People Wearing Masks in Travis County, TX per 100 people







Austin MSA COVID-19 Patients Under 18 Years of Age







Race and Ethnicity of Travis County Residents Ages 5-11









Race/Ethnicity Demographics of Travis County Vaccine Distribution

Travis County 5+ Census Population Estimate




Fully Vaccinated Travis County Residents by Race and Ethnicity






Travis County Residents Up-To-Date With Vaccines


Travis County by Vaccination Status for Week of February 6, 2022


