November 18, 2021 - Austin Housing Finance Corporation Board authorized negotiation and execution of a loan with Summertree Development, LLC, or an affiliated entity, in an amount not to exceed \$2,040,000 for an ownership development to be known as 7308 South Congress, located at or near 7308 South Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas 78745.

#### Additional Backup Information:

If approved, AHFC is authorized to enter into a loan agreement and related documents with Summertree Developer, LLC, or an affiliated entity, for an ownership housing development to be located in Council District 2.

<u>Project Information:</u> Project funding is to be utilized for pre-development costs of the ownership housing development consisting of 74 condos, of which 37 units will be market rate. The affordable units will be a mix of one-bedroom, and two-bedroom condos available for sale to households earning at or below 80% Median Family Income (MFI).

<u>Prior AHFC Funding:</u> Prior funding in the amount of \$2,040,000 was used for land acquisition costs. If this request is approved, the total funding for this development will be \$2,500,000.
