

## AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

WORK SESSION MEETING TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2022

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Work Session Meeting on Tuesday, February 15, 2022 301 W. Second Street, Austin, TX and via Videoconference.

B1. Inclusive Procurement Working Group Presentation
