## Additional Backup Information:

The contract is for the purchase and installation of two automotive floor lifts at Fleet Service Centers. The lifts will be used to perform maintenance and repairs on heavy duty vehicles. The work performed by City technicians on City-owned heavy-duty vehicles with the aid of the additional lifts will increase Fleet Mobility Services' responsiveness to City departments for maintenance and repairs handled in-house.

If the City is unable to secure a contract for this purchase, Fleet Mobility Services will be forced to send more heavy-duty vehicles to contract vendors for repair services, which will result in higher operational costs and increased vehicle down time.
