### **Posting Language**

Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the existing agreement with Central Texas Community Health Center to provide HIV-related prevention services, to add funding in an amount not to exceed \$187,534, for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$485,994.

### **Lead Department**

Austin Public Health.

### **Fiscal Note**

Funding in the amount of \$902,686 is available in the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Austin Public Health Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund. Funding for the remaining contract term is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

### **Prior Council Action:**

September 2, 2021 - Council approved Resolution No. 20210902-027, which approved an agreement with Central Texas Community Health Center for an initial 12-month term with three optional 12-month extensions, in an amount not to exceed \$85,209 for the initial term and each extension option, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$340,836, on a 10-0 vote.
