Recommendation

Pursue all available measures to increase staffing to sustainable levels for all summer camp programming.

RATIONALE:

The Parks and Recreation Board recommends to the Parks and Recreation Department and Austin City Council to pursue all available measures to increase staffing to sustainable levels for all summer camp programming, including but not limited to the following measures:

- 1) increasing pay rates for all summer camp staff;
- 2) allocating additional funding as needed to the Parks and Recreation Department to fulfill fully staffed summer camps during summer 2022;
- 3) any other measures found by the Austin City Council or the Parks and Recreation Department to be effective in training and retaining summer camp and afterschool program staff.
