Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 8 to an agreement with Foundation Communities for services addressing academic performance and childhood obesity for low-income youth, to add one 15-month extension option in an amount not to exceed \$194,510 for the term beginning July 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023, for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$1,233,861.

Fiscal Note

Funding in the amount of \$194,510 is available in the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Austin Public Health Department Operating Budget.

Prior Council Action:

September 30, 2021- Council authorized negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 7 to add one ninemonth extension option in an amount not to exceed \$116,706 for the term October 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022, for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$1,039,351, on a 10-1 vote with Council Member Kelly voting no.

March 31, 2016 - Council authorized adding a 6% annual cost of living increase to the 37-month base agreement and each of the three extension options, on an 8-2 vote with Council Members Troxclair and Zimmerman voting no, Mayor Adler absent, and Mayor Pro-Tem Tovo recusing herself from contracts associated with Creative Action.

November 20, 2014 - Council authorized execution of a 37-month agreement with 33 social service agencies or other qualified offerors to Request for Proposal No. EAD0116, for self-sufficiency social services for the Austin/Travis County Health and Human Services Department, including an agreement with Foundation Communities with three 12-month extension options, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$840,000, on a 6-0 vote with Council Member Tovo recusing herself from contracts associated with Theater Action Project/Creative Action.

This action will authorize negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 8 to an agreement with Foundation Communities to provide funding for services addressing academic performance and childhood obesity for low-income youth.

Amendment No. 7 exercised the fourth extension option in the amount of \$\$116,706 for the period of October 1, 2021to June 30, 2022.

Amendment No. 6 exercised the third extension option in the amount of \$155,608 for the period of October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021.

Amendment No. 5 exercised the second extension option in the amount of \$155,608 for the period of October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020.

Amendment No. 4 exercised the first extension option in the amount of \$155,608 for the period of October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019.

Amendment No. 3 added \$3,795 to the 37-month base agreement with a 2.5% cost of living increase to the agreement approved by Council for Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

Amendment No. 2 added \$6,826 to the to the 37-month base agreement with a 2.3% cost of living increase to the agreement approved by Council for Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

Amendment No. 1 added \$25,200 to the to the 37-month base agreement with a 6% cost of living increase to the agreement approved by Council for Fiscal Year 2015-2016.

The current social services agreement with Foundation Communities, Inc. PATHS program was awarded because of Austin Public Health Department's Self-Sufficiency Request for Applications. Services began on September 1, 2015 for an initial 37-month term ending on September 30, 2018 in the amount of \$420,000, with three 12-month extension options each in an amount not to exceed \$140,000, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$840,000.
