ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING INITIAL PERMANENT ZONING FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 6529 VAUGHT RANCH ROAD AND CHANGING THE ZONING MAP FROM INTERIM RURAL RESIDENCE (I-RR) DISTRICT TO LIMITED OFFICE-MIXED USE-CONDITIONAL OVERLAY (LO-MU-CO) COMBINING DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The zoning map established by Section 25-2-191 of the City Code is amended to change the base district from interim-rural residence (I-RR) district to limited office-mixed use-conditional overlay (LO-MU-CO) combining district on the property described in Zoning Case No. C14-2021-0159, on file at the Housing and Planning Department, as follows:

Lot 4, Block A, VAUGHT RANCH SEC 2, a subdivision in Travis County, Texas, according to the map or plat thereof as recorded in Document No. 200600158 of the Plat Records of Travis County, Texas (the "Property"),

locally known as 6529 Vaught Ranch Road in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, generally identified in the map attached as **Exhibit "A"**.

PART 2. The Property within the boundaries of the conditional overlay combining district established by this ordinance is subject to the following conditions:

The following uses are prohibited uses on the Property:


Club or lodge	College and university facilities
Day care services (commercial)	Day care services (general)
Day care services (limited)	Hospital services (limited)
Medical offices (exceeding 5,000	Private secondary educational facilities
square feet gross floor area)	
Public primary educational facilities	Public secondary educational facilities

PART 3. Except as specifically restricted under this ordinance, the Property may be developed and used in accordance with the regulations established for the limited office (LO) base district, mixed use (MU) combining district and other applicable requirements of the City Code.
