#### **ORDER NO. 1**

## BASE RATE REVIEW INFORMATION; NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT DISCUSSION; NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY CONFERENCE AND FINAL CONFERENCE; AND ADMITTING PARTICIPANTS

This Order No. 1 is issued by the Impartial Hearing Examiner in order to provide participants with information and important notices regarding the 2022 Base Rate Filing Package of the City of Austin's (City) municipally owned electric utility, Austin Energy (Austin Energy).

#### I. BACKGROUND

On April 18, 2022, Austin Energy issued the 2022 Base Rate Filing Package, which initiated a Base Rate Review process (Base Rate Review). On the same date, Austin Energy also issued Austin Energy's Letter to Participants regarding Cost of Service Model (Austin Energy Cost of Service Letter).

The Impartial Hearing Examiner is a neutral third party designated by the Austin City Council to review information from Austin Energy, community stakeholders, and customer groups participating in the Base Rate Review. A further description of the duties of the Impartial Hearing Examiner may be found at the City's webpages and the Procedural Guidelines (addressed below).

#### II. BASE RATE REVIEW INFORMATION

#### A. Procedural Guidelines

### **B.** The Filing System

#### C. Scope of Base Rate Review

The issues to be addressed in the Base Rate Review are set forth in the 2022 Base Rate Filing Package and addressed in the Procedural Guidelines, including Section A in the Procedural Guidelines, entitled "Scope."

#### D. No Ex Parte Communications with the Impartial Hearing Examiner

Ex Parte communications with the Impartial Hearing Examiner are prohibited. Ex Parte communications are defined in Section A(3)(b)(1) of the Procedural Guidelines as:

(1) Ex parte communications. Unless specifically authorized by law, the Impartial Hearing Examiner cannot communicate, directly or indirectly, about any issue of law or fact related to the Base Rate Review with any Person or Participant, or their Authorized Representatives, unless all

Participants know about and have an opportunity to participate in the communication.

*Ex Parte* communications are prohibited to ensure that all participants in the Base Rate Review have an opportunity to hear and respond to any substantive information provided to the Impartial Hearings Examiner by any participant in the Base Rate Review.

# III. BASE RATE REVIEW SCHEDULE AND NOTICES OF PRELIMINARY AND FINAL CONFERENCES

Austin Energy has set a Procedural Schedule for the Base Rate Review process. All participants should review and abide by the schedule, including attendance at the Settlement Discussion, the Preliminary Conference, and the Final Conference. Note that the settlement Discussion, Preliminary Conference, and Final Conference will all be held at:

#### A. Notice of Settlement Discussion

As set forth in the Procedural Schedule, a Settlement Discussion will take place on <u>July 11-12, 2022</u>. The start time of the Settlement Discussion is to be announced. All participants are encouraged to attend the Settlement Conference to possibly resolve some or all of the issues to be addressed in the Base Rate Review.

#### **B.** Notice of Preliminary Conference

As set forth in the Procedural Schedule, a Preliminary Conference will take place beginning at **9 a.m. on July 12, 2022**. All participants are strongly encouraged to attend the Preliminary Conference, as the Impartial Hearing Examiner may discuss and make rulings on procedures and substantive matters to ensure a fair, impartial, and efficient Final Conference.

C. Notice of Final Conference

As set forth in the Procedural Schedule, a Final Conference will take place beginning at

9 a.m. on July 13, 2022, and continue until the completion of the Final Conference on or before

July 15, 2022. All participants are strongly encouraged to attend the Final Conference. As defined

in Section A(2)(e) in the Procedural Guidelines, the Final Conference is:

The proceeding conducted by the Impartial Hearing Examiner during which Austin

Energy and the Participants present their Position Statements and oral remarks regarding the 2022 Austin Energy Base Rate Review for a final recommendation

by the Impartial Hearing Examiner to City Council.

IV. **ADMITTING PARTICIPANTS** 

The following have filed requests to participate. Section C(4)(b) of the Procedural

Guidelines requires that a response to a motion be filed no more than seven days after the motion

is filed. More than seven days have passed since the requests to participate were filed. No response
