Committee members did not find the design compatible with the Travis Heights-Fairview Park National Register District. Discussion included the lot would accommodate keeping the house and adding an addition onto the back, the proposed design was a barrier to its surroundings and stark, and the design should be more approachable and maintain current setbacks. Members recommended bringing a one-story presence out in front and moving parking to the side or rear, reducing the sizeable second-story window size, and overall making the design more compatible because it significantly diverges from the historic streetscape.

Staff Recommendation: Comment on the plans, then encourage rehabilitation and adaptive reuse, then relocation over demolition, but release

the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package.
