

RESOLUTION NO. 20220421-022

WHEREAS, the City of Austin (the “City”) and the Texas Department of Transportation (“TxDOT”) previously entered into an Advance Funding Agreement related to the expansion of FM 734 (the “734 AFA”); and

WHEREAS, in November 2020, TxDOT suspended all work related to the 734 AFA and the City and TxDOT have terminated the 734 AFA; and

WHEREAS, City staff is recommending that the funding previously allocated to the 734 AFA be reallocated due to the impossibility of completing that project: and

WHEREAS, the improvement of West Parmer Lane between SH 45 and Brushy Creek Road (the “Project”) was named a Regional Mobility Project in the City of Austin’s 2016 Mobility Bond contract with the voters (Ordinance No. 20160818-023 and Resolution No. 20160818-074); and

WHEREAS, the Lakeline Boulevard Extension project (the “Lakeline Project”) will improve Lakeline Boulevard between Lyndhurst Street and West Parmer Lane; and

WHEREAS, the Lakeline Project will improve the connection between West Parmer Lane and the Capital Metro Lakeline Station Park and Ride and is critical to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City and TxDOT executed an Advance Funding Agreement related to design work for the Lakeline Project (the “Lakeline AFA”); and

WHEREAS, the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization has approved project funding for the engineering phase of the Lakeline Project with Surface Transportation Block Grant, and listed in the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the City and TxDOT now desire to terminate the Lakeline AFA and enter into a new advance funding agreement for the engineering phase of the Lakeline Project; and


WHEREAS, City staff recommend the Project money previously allocated to the 734 AFA should now be used to fund improvements related to the Lakeline Project; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Council authorizes negotiation and execution of an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for the engineering phase of the Lakeline Project for an estimated amount of \$580,500 plus all cost overruns associated with the project. The City Manager or delegated officials are authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.
