

e-Bike Rebates

 Austin Energy e-Ride Rebates, as part of a larger transportation electrification program, offers individual rebates up to \$300 per bike for individuals and up to \$400 per bike for fleets

• Supports local e-bike dealers

Vision – to create a future of mobility that is equitable, affordable, and accessible while helping the environment


- Conducted 100s of e-bike access and safety trainings for underserved community members



e-Bike Infrastructure & Affordability

Multi-Family e-Bike Mobility Hub Pilot



In Collaboration with Chestnut Neighborhood Revitalization Corp, Austin Energy & Mod Bikes

- Pilot property includes 75% affordable housing
- Property has no parking and is a mobility hub:
 - Onsite e-bike charging; safe & secure
 - e-bikes for each resident
 - Also, residential car share & public transit access
- Austin small business fabricated e-bike racks
- System is modular so it can be customized by property needs
- Sub meter installation to study consumption
- Resident engagement to include conduct surveys, marketing, outreach, onsite signage, and lockers
