Texas Industrial Energy Consumers ("TIEC"), propose the following questions and concerns be addressed in the Austin Energy Base Rate Review:

- 1. Are the rates proposed by Austin Energy just and reasonable?
- 2. Is Austin Energy proposing a reasonable methodology for allocating those costs among different types of classes of customers?
- 3. Are the rate classes Austin Energy has proposed reasonable?
- 4. Is Austin Energy's rate proposal based on cost-of-service, and does it appropriately minimize subsidization of customers across different classes and usage characteristics?
- 5. Should any other requirements or conditions be imposed to ensure that Austin Energy provides reliable, cost-effective service to large users?
