ORDINANCE NO. 2 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HOURS TO OPERATE SOUND EQUIPMENT DURING WILLIE NELSON'S 49TH ANNUAL FOURTH OF 4 JULY PICNIC TO BE HELD ON JULY 4, 2022. **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN: PART 1.** The council finds the following: 6 The 49th Annual Willie Nelson's Fourth of July Picnic (49th Picnic) (1)is scheduled for Monday, July 4, 2022, and will be held in Austin's city limits; 9 This year marks the first time the event being held in-person after 10 (2)going virtual in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic; The 49th Picnic will be held for the first time at Q2 Stadium, the 12 (3) 13 home of Major League Soccer's Austin FC; The 49th Picnic will be the first-ever concert at Q2 Stadium; 14 (4) 15 (5) Stadium staff will construct a temporary floor and band stage on the grass pitch to accommodate the 49th Picnic; 16 17 City Code Section 4-20-43 (Sound Equipment for Outdoor Special (6)Event Venues) authorizes outdoor amplified sound up to midnight on 18 the night before Independence Day, but reverts to standard limits on 19 Independence Day itself; 20 (7)July 4th, 2022, falls on a Monday, meaning outdoor amplified sound is only allowed up to 10:30 p.m.; 23 (8) The 49th Picnic will kick off at 11:00 a.m., and organizers request a modest extension of 30 minutes on the amplified sound limit to 11:00 25 p.m., which will allow the full slate of musicians to take the stage for 26 guests to enjoy.
