Conduct a public hearing on the City's draft HOME American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) Allocation Plan that will be submitted to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development as part of the City's application for \$11,441,252 in federal funding through a HOME-ARP grant.

Prior Council Action:

May 19, 2022 - Council set a public hearing for June 9, 2022, to receive citizen input on the City's draft HOME American Rescue Plan Allocation Plan.

June 10, 2021 - Council adopted Resolution No. 20210610-077, which adopted the American Rescue Plan Act Spending Framework and authorized the City Manager to make the necessary allocations.

Additional Backup Information:

Through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Congress appropriated \$5 billion to address homelessness and housing instability, in a grant referred to as the HOME American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP). The City of Austin is eligible to receive 11,441,252 through HOME-ARP, and can allocate the grant towards one or multiple of the following categories:

- Supportive Services
- Acquisition and Development of Non-Congregate Shelters
- Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA)
- Development of Affordable Rental Housing
- Non-profit Operating Expenses
- Non-profit Capacity Building
- Planning and Administration

In order to receive this funding, the City must submit a spending plan, referred to as an allocation plan, to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as an amendment to the City's Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Action Plan.

In accordance with HUD requirements, a draft HOME-ARP Allocation Plan is available online and in person for

the public to review and comment on until June 10th, 2022. The plan is also available as backup to this item. The draft Allocation Plan proposes a spending plan for the grant and describes the process City staff went through to gather feedback from the community. The requested public hearing is to solicit feedback on the proposed spending plan outlined in the draft HOME-ARP Allocation Plan.

The Homeless Strategy Division of Austin Public Health, in coordination with the Housing and Planning Department, is proposing to allocate HOME-ARP across the following activities:

- Acquisition and Development of Non-Congregate Shelters \$8,000,000 (70%)
- Development of Affordable Rental Housing \$1,000,000 (9%)
- Supportive Services \$725,064.20 (6%)
- Planning and Administration \$1,716,187.80 (15%)
- Total grant amount \$11,441,252 (100%)
