## **MOTION SHEET**

I move to amend Item #51 as follows:

### **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City Manager is directed to work with the Office of Sustainability, ~~GAVA~~, the Chief Resilience Office, the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, Austin Independent School District, ~~and~~ Travis County, and nonprofit organizations with a proven track record of engaging diverse communities to produce a “resilience hub toolkit,” the components of which should include a disaster preparedness guide, online resources for non-city entities interested in hosting a resilience hub, and possible community trainings. The City Manager shall also make available information about City resources that may be available to support this work, such as the Neighborhood Partnering Program, solar panels, and low-interest loans. While the Council expects that this work will evolve and change over time, the City Manager shall make available the first iteration of this work by October 2, 2022;
