The City Manager's Office has reviewed this grant for alignment as directed by Resolution 20200611-096 and recommends approval. The contract is for the one-time purchase of a NOVO digital radiography rover, Toughpad tablet, and associated accessories for the Explosive Ordnance Disposal Team. The NOVO system is faster, digital, and to be used to identify and determine if an item is a threat to community safety. The requested equipment are replacements for an antiquated system that is slower and does not provide a detailed and defined picture. If the City is unable to secure a contract, the Explosive Ordnance Disposal Team will continue to use obsolete equipment negatively impacting community safety, and it may result in the Austin Police Department losing grant funding to purchase the equipment.
