### **Posting Language**

Authorize negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 1 to an agreement with Mexic-Arte Museum to provide preventative early intervention services, to add four twelve-month extension options each in the amount not to exceed \$155,344, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$776,720.

### **Lead Department**

Austin Public Health.

### **Fiscal Note**

Funding in the amount of \$155,344 is available in the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Austin Public Health Department Operating Budget. Funding for the remaining terms is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

### **Prior Council Action:**

August 26, 2021 - Council authorized negotiation and execution of the agreement with Mexic-Arte Museum, on a 9-1 vote, with Mayor Pro Tem Harper-Madison off the dais.

### **Additional Backup Information:**

Approval of this item will authorize the Austin Public Health Department's Office of Violence Prevention to negotiate and execute a 12-month extension of this agreement with Mexic-Arte. Mexic-Arte's Community Art and Screen It! Program, which will continue to promote positive youth development by addressing the needs of underserved youth and offer Preventative Early Intervention (also referred to as PEI) through arts instruction to students and teachers in targeted locations throughout Austin.

The current social services agreement with Mexic-Arte Museum began providing services on September 15, 2021, for an initial 12-month term ending on September 30, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$155,344.
