# Additional Backup Information:

In response to Resolution No 20211021-027 and as part of the overall Living Streets Initiative, this amendment and updates to the current City Code regarding Neighborhood Blocks Parties will help achieve the directive given to the City Manager to make block parties easier to organize and more equitably accessible to all residents and neighbors.

## Changes include:

- (1) clarification on approval requirements from occupants of properties impacted by the party; and
- (2) expanding opportunities for parties on some residential streets that are not solely abutted by single-family dwellings (e.g., residential streets with multi-family dwellings, schools, places of worship, commercial properties)
