Additional Backup Information:

The Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) is in the process of identifying and replacing ball field light fixtures throughout the park system. This is largely due to a structural safety, as two large wooden poles have fallen in the last few years. In addition, the current older fixture light bulbs will be unreplaceable within the next five years.

PARD has identified a priority site for replacement with wooden poles at the fields located on Cesar Chavez. This site is utilized by the West Austin Youth Association youth sports organization. With this being a safety priority, PARD obtained a quote and was able to identify funds in this fiscal year that will not be available in next year's budget.
