- 4. Direct the City Manager to provide annual public reports on the efficacy of floodplain redevelopment exceptions, <u>FEMA REQUIREMENTS</u>, and the goals to increase public safety and decrease flood risks in floodplains. <u>THE REPORT SHOULD BE PRESENTED TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION FOR COMMENT</u>, and
- 5. Provide clear concise definitions and examples of "substantial improvement" and "no adverse flooding impact" in the proposed code amendments. <u>ADVERSE FLOOD IMPACTS SHALL CONSIDER BOTH THE PROPERTY AND THE ADJACENT PROPERTIES HISTORIC FLOOD PATTERNS, USE MODELING THAT SHOWS THE GREATEST POSSIBLE FLOODING IMPACT, AND CONSIDER FLOW RATES, and</u>
