Additional Information

The City Manager is directed to explore whether and how the mission and workplans of the Austin Civilian Conservation Corps should include (1) providing pathways to jobs specifically for people experiencing homelessness who otherwise would not have access to or have difficulty accessing employment, or (2) to otherwise support and be a part of our community's homelessness response system, including for example assisting with placemaking efforts associated with the HEAL initiative. This exploration should include input from ACCC, APH, EDD, and HSO staff with a report back to Council no later than the first quarter of 2023.

The City Manager is further directed to prepare an evaluation of the Austin Civilian Conservation Corps pilot that includes, without limitation, the number of and how it has helped put people on intended pathways to employment, how it has helped advance conservation and sustainability goals, and supports the homeless response system consistent with the above, and details on how the City Manager intends to build out the program over time.
