Additional Information

Per staff communication, \$250,000 in emergency rental assistance or relocation assistance and for tenants facing displacement and \$450,000 from the Housing Trust Fund will be allocated to establish a \$700,000 Tenant Relocation Program in response to the Tenant Notification and Relocation Ordinance. This program will launch in FY 2023. This rider requires the City Manager, upon the adoption of the budget, to provide an update to Council on the status of the solicitation process at 30 days, 60 days, and 90 days.

Displacement in Austin is actively occurring and displacement prevention is a strategic goal of the city. The pilot Displacement Prevention Navigator program was adopted during the FY21-22 budget cycle and will only be launched in 2023. It is necessary to ensure we launch anti-displacement programs in a timely manner.
