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Additional Information

The City Manager is directed to explore whether and how the Austin Civilian Conservation Corps (ACCC) mission and workplans (1) should include pathways to jobs specifically for people experiencing homelessness who otherwise would not have access to or would have difficulty accessing employment, or (2) should otherwise support and be a part of our community's homelessness response system (for example, assisting with placemaking efforts associated with the HEAL initiative). This exploration should include input from ACCC, APH, EDD, and HSO staff with a report back to Council no later than the first quarter of 2023.

The City Manager is further directed to prepare an evaluation of the Austin Civilian Conservation Corps pilot that includes the number of individuals served and evaluates how the program has helped put people on pathways to employment, and how it has helped advance conservation and sustainability goals as well as how the ACCC has enhanced and can enhance the homeless response system. Finally, the City Manager shall detail and outline how he intends to build out the ACCC program over the next five years.
