Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 1 to an agreement with the Council on At-Risk Youth to provide evidence-based Youth Violence Prevention Curriculum, to add four 12-month extension options each in an amount not to exceed \$400,000, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

Fiscal Note

Funding in the amount of \$400,000 is included in the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Proposed Austin Public Health Department Operating Budget and is contingent upon Council approval at budget adoption. Funding for the remaining terms is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Prior Council Action:

August 26, 2021 - Council authorized negotiation and execution of agreement with the Council on At-Risk Youth, on a 9-1 vote, with Mayor Pro Tem Harper-Madison off the dais.

Additional Backup Information:

Approval of this item will authorize the Austin Public Health Department's Office of Violence Prevention to negotiate and execute a 12-month extension of the agreement with the Council on At Risk Youth and will ensure the continuation of their PeaceRox Program, which reduces the likelihood of youth entering the school-to-prison pipeline based on serious disciplinary referrals, including drug use, gang involvement, and violence. The Council on At Risk Youth's curriculum provides life skills training, anger management training, one-on-one counseling, and group counseling.

The current social services agreement with the Council on At Risk Youth began providing services on September 15, 2021 for an initial 12-month term ending on September 30, 2022 in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.
