Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 5 to an agreement with Ending Community Homelessness Coalition, Inc. to actively connect individuals experiencing homelessness in Austin/Travis County to opportunities for safe, stable, and permanent housing, to add one 12-month extension option in an amount not to exceed \$130,000, for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$780,000.

Prior Council Action:

December 14, 2017 - Council approved a 10-month agreement with Ending Community Homelessness Coalition, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$130,000, with four 12-month extension options each in an amount not to exceed \$130,000, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$650,000, on a 10-0 vote, with Council Member Pool off the dais.
