Impacts of Teleworking

Council Resolution 20220616-087

- Directed the City Manager "to conduct a study of office space occupancy rates at City facilities as a result of remote work schedules and other changes in office space needs, and to provide recommendations to the Council."
 - Surveys in progress (Expansion from surveys conducted in Spring 2022)
 - Data collection from timekeeping systems
- Space requirement estimates for departments currently in lease space total 173,000 sq. ft.
- ☐ Facilities under consideration to relocate departments in lease space include:
 - Permitting and Development Center
 - Town Lake Center
 - One Texas Center



Public Safety Campus



Rutherford Lane Campus (RLC) for Public Safety

- Large site (32.55 acre) able to accommodate all departments and ancillary operations
- Replace APD HQ, TechniCenter & RBJ with new facilities and allow redevelopment
- Public Safety facilities qualify for COs/debt service tax rate

Delivery: PFC

Space Programming: completed Community Engagement: Sept/Oct.

RFP: Beginning of 2023



Johnny Morris Service Center

Johnny Morris Service Center

- Joint Austin Resource Recovery and Fleet Services Service Center
- Provides a North Austin site which relieves overcrowding at Harold Court
- Office and warehousing included
- Community outreach conducted as part of Design Criteria Manual completion





Project Delivery

Public Facilities Corporation (PFC)

- PFC would allow the City to utilize acquisition/construction approach very similar to PDC and AEHQ projects
- PFC holds ground lease
- Runs RFP for developer team who finances construction
- PFC issues debt at completion to pay developer
- Leases property back to City
- Lease same as debt service
- City purchases building from PFC
- Request Council approval to create the PFC September 15th agenda
