Additional Backup Information:

The Austin Police Department (APD) Special Events Unit will provide to UT Austin, on an as needed basis, assistance in the planning and execution of street closures, parades, political protests and VIP escorts. APD will establish crowd control measures at events and maintain law and order. The APD special events team will closely monitor events with other Austin Center for Events (ACE) members. With applicable input from ACE members, the APD may alter original plans to address public safety concerns, as needed. APD also will provide specialty services, such K9, explosive, and air support specialists, as needed. All APD police officers working at an event are governed by APD department policy to ensure that a professional service is delivered within the tourism-policing model.
