

HEAL Initiative: An Overview from Inception

More than 300 people have been placed into shelter since HEAL's inception




Average Time from Shelter Entry to Housing Move-In: 173 days (~5.7 months)

- 90% Shelter Acceptance Rate
- * Includes August data from decommissioning Roy G. Guerrero
- ** Data through July 31, 2022



HEAL FY22: Performance and Progress

The City has exceeded its FY22 goal of connecting 200 people to bridge shelter



Average Time from Shelter Entry to Housing Move-In: 106 days (~3.5 months)

- The HEAL Initiative has served 109% of its FY22 goal
- As HEAL operations have progressed, the average length of time between shelter entry to housing move in has decreased, indicating increased efficiency




HEAL Initiative: HEAL Encampments






HEAL Shelter Population

HEAL is serving African American and non-Hispanic White clients at rates greater than their representation of people experiencing homelessness

Hispanic/Latinx appear to underrepresented, potentially due to greater percentage of Hispanic/Latinx family units, who tend to be sheltered.



HEAL Race and Ethnicity Comparison

Note: Totals do not add to 100%. A small percent of the populations are from other races/ethnicities.



HEAL Initiative: Bridge Shelter Exits


44% of HEAL shelter clients leave shelter to housing

65% (213) people have <u>exited</u> Bridge Shelter since HEALs inception:

- Exits to Housing: 44% (94 people)
- Return to Homelessness (RTH) Exits: 48% (102 people)
 - > 38 of which maintained enrollment in housing programs)
- ≻Unknown Exits: 6% (13 people)

Average Length of Time by Exit Destination

Exit to Housing: 163 daysRTH Exits: 76 days



44% of HEAL Shelter Clients exit directly from shelter to positive destinations.
