This action will accept \$187,412 in grant funds from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Truancy Prevention Grant Program; and amend the FY 2021-2022 Police Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund of Ordinance No. 20210811-001 to appropriate \$187,412 for the Austin Juvenile Justice and Truancy Prevention Project for the 1-year grant period (September 1, 2022 - August 31, 2023). Funding will allow the City to implement an evidence-based truancy prevention program by hiring two OVP Program Specialists and one Program Coordinator. In addition, funding will cover the purchase of curriculum, supplies and participant certifications.
