
**DATA FOUNDRY, LLC'S NOTICE OF NO CORRECTIONS OR EXCEPTIONS TO
THE IMPARTIAL HEARING EXAMINER'S FINAL RECOMMENDATION**

Data Foundry, LLC (“Data Foundry”) has reviewed the Impartial Hearing Examiner’s (“IHE’s”) Final Recommendation filed by the on September 9, 2022 respectively. Data Foundry has not identified any corrections or exceptions. Therefore, Data Foundry will not be filing corrections or exceptions to the Final Recommendation.

Data Foundry agrees with the Final Recommendation “that the proposed tariff be adopted, creating the PRI-2 HLF rate class” (Final Recommendation at 141) and that customers in the PRI-2 HLF rate class be afforded the same exemption from a compulsory energy efficiency surcharge as granted to larger high load factor customers in the Austin Energy service territory and to similarly situated industrial customers in territories near Austin with retail competition. (*Id.* at 142). Further, Data Foundry strongly supports the Final Recommendation’s finding that “[h]igh load factor customers should not be required to report on their energy efficiency measures, which they have clearly stated are proprietary and confidential.” (*Id.* at 143).

Data Foundry respectfully asks that the City Council approve the creation of the PRI-2 HLF rate class as proposed by Austin Energy.
