


Level of engagement of all present. Exciting to see the culmination (of just one step of the process) of so much hard, focused, dedicated work. Genuine joy at working together to see this happen!

I really enjoyed the blessing ceremony. It was fun to experience a different culture and learn more about it. It was cool that TTF thought to do something like this.










