Approve an ordinance creating the Austin/Travis County Public Health Commission to serve as an advisory board to City Council concerning public health programs, projects, and services within Austin and Travis County.

#### Additional Backup Information:

Approval of the ordinance will authorize the creation of a joint Public Health Commission, with the application process to open in mid-October 2022, and a start date of January 2023. The Commission will be responsible for the following:

- 1. Explore the best/evidence-based public health practices for areas that need improvement and provide recommendations
- 2. Provide an annual formal recommendation on the improvement of the overall public health programs, projects, regulations, and services within the governing entities in the city and the county
- 3. Work to inform strategies that address health disparities that impact health outcomes for underserved populations
- 4. Gather input from the community on budget and programming recommendations to share with policymakers and health agencies annually
- 5. Report periodically to the Public Health Committee of the Austin City Council and the Travis County Commissioners Court (or the appropriate committee thereof).
