March 12, 2015 - Council approved the negotiation and execution of the interlocal agreements between the City and Lakeway, Rollingwood, West Lake Hills, Pflugerville, and Sunset Valley to obtain address and annexation related data for regional 911 support and ensure compliance with the interlocal agreement between the City and the Capital Area Emergency Communications District.

September 29, 2022 - Council approved the negotiation and execution of an interlocal agreement with the Capital Area Council of Governments authorizing the City to maintain and update the Capital Area Emergency Communications District's 9-1-1 Geographic Information System database for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.
