Posting Language

Conduct a public hearing to consider an ordinance relating to the full-purpose annexation of approximately 498 acres of City-owned property located in Travis County northwest of the intersection of Yaupon Drive and Spicewood Springs Road and approving a written plan for the provision of municipal services. Case number: C7a-2022-0007. The area is in Austin limited purpose jurisdiction as well as extraterritorial jurisdiction adjacent to Council Districts 6 and 10.

Additional Backup Information:

This item proposes the voluntary full-purpose annexation of about 498 acres of City-owned land that was purchased for purposes including conservation and protection of water quality. The area to be annexed is currently in Austin limited purpose jurisdiction as well as extraterritorial jurisdiction. The current use of the area is unpopulated conservation land and recreation uses. The land to be annexed consists of the parcels below:

- 3M Tract 214.6 acres
- Boatright Tract 9.0 acres
- Bugh Gibson Tract 6.8 acres
- Gibson Tract 8.7 acres
- Hilltop Tract 50.4 acres
- Kruger Tract 95.7 acres
- Hiller Tract 16.9 acres
- High Vista Tract 10.0 acres
- Ngo Tract 4.9 acres
- St. Edwards 79.8 acres
- Hilltop Roadway 1.3 acres

As a note, the previous notice included a 10-acre tract, the Hough Tract, that has since been removed from the proposed annexation case.

State law requires a municipality to provide notice and conduct a public hearing to provide persons interested in annexation the opportunity to be heard. The City Council may adopt an ordinance annexing the area for full purposes, including a written plan for the provision of municipal services, at the conclusion of the public hearing.
