Motion #4: Amend PART 14. Public Art

I move to amend language to establish sufficient funding for Art in Public Places.

The Statesman PUD will participate in the Art in Public Places (AIPP) program. The Landowner shall spend a minimum of \$1,500,000.00 dollars on the art pieces and installation with a preference for local artists. The Landowner shall provide a minimum of two art pieces approved by the director of Economic Development Department to be displayed in a-prominent locations on the Property, or the Landowner shall make an approved contribution to the AIPP program. The Landowner will review the public art plan with the City's AIPP Manager for approval. The City shall not issue the final certificate of occupancy for the first phase of any development in the Statesman PUD until at least \$750,000 of the approved art is installed fund and an approved art pieces are on display within phase one of the property. or receipt of contribution has been made to the AIPP for future installation of art on the Property. The City shall not issue the final certificate of occupancy for the second phase of development in the Statesman PUD until after the balance of the \$1,500,000 is expended on approved art piece(s) and is on display within the Statesman PUD property.
