HISTORIC BUILDINGS NEW ADDITIONS

"Placing functions and services required for the new use in non-character-defining interior spaces rather than installing a new addition."

Constructing a new addition so that there is the least possible loss of historic materials and so that character-defining features are not obscured, damaged, or destroyed.

Locating the attached exterior addition at the rear or on an inconspicuous side of a historic building; and limiting its size and scale in relationship to the historic building.

Designing new additions in a manner that makes clear what is historic and what is new."
