

 TGS met with Kevin Kluge and Jacob Johnson from Austin Water to explore collaboration opportunities.






Commercial Program Highlights

Residential Program Participation






Low-Income/Free Equipment Program

Due to increased demand to the program the LI/FE Program has suspended accepting applications for appliance replacements until January of 2023.

109 appliances were replaced throughout Central Texas prior to the depletion of program funds.
