BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The Council finds that all of the recitals contained in this resolution are true and adopts them as findings of fact by this governing body; and

The Council finds that the results of the general election as tabulated and canvassed reflect the votes cast at the election; and

The Council accepts and approves the returns for the general election, as tabulated and received and canvassed, and declares that the following persons are declared elected and may qualify for the office indicated for terms that begin January 6, 2023:

City Council Member District 8 _____; and

In order to elect a Mayor and City Council Members for Districts 3, 5, and 9, the City Council shall order a runoff election as soon as is practicable and no later than the fifth day after this canvass as required by state law (Texas Election Code § 2.024).

The Council finds that the results of the special election as tabulated and canvassed reflect the votes cast at the election; and

The Council accepts and approves the returns for the special election, as tabulated and received and canvassed, and declares that Proposition A is adopted.

With this canvass, Council is making official the precinct returns received from the counties.
