8 **PART 1.** A municipal runoff election shall be held in the City of Austin on December
9 13, 2022, in accordance with the provisions of Article II and Article III of the Austin City
10 Charter and the laws of the State of Texas. At the election there shall be elected by
11 majority vote of the qualified voters of District 3 a City Council Member for District 3,
12 by majority vote of the qualified voters of District 5 a City Council Member for District
13 5, and by majority vote of the qualified voters of District 9 a City Council Member for
14 District 9. The candidates for District 3 shall meet all requirements for and shall be
15 residents of District 3, the candidates for District 5 shall meet all requirements for and
16 shall be residents of District 5, and the candidates for District 9 shall meet all
17 requirements for and shall be residents of District 9.

18 **PART 2.** The election shall be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
19 The location of the main early voting polling place, the dates and hours for early voting,
20 and the early voting clerk's official mailing address; the precincts and locations of the
21 election day polling places; the dates, hours, and locations of the early voting places; and
22 the names of the officers appointed to conduct the election are provided in Exhibits A-F
23 attached and incorporated as a part of this ordinance.

24 **PART 3.** A direct recording electronic voting system, as the term is defined in Title 8 of
25 the Texas Election Code, shall be used for early voting and for voting conducted on
26 election day. The central counting station is established at the Travis County Elections
27 Division, 5501 Airport Boulevard, Austin, Texas.

PART 4. Notice of this election shall be given by posting and publishing a copy of this ordinance in both English and Spanish. The notice and a copy of this ordinance shall be posted, in both English and Spanish, in the office of the City Clerk and at the City Hall notice kiosk not later than the 15th day before election day. Notice of this election shall be published one time, not earlier than the 30th day before the date of the election or later than the 10th day before the date of the election, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Austin.

PART 5. The candidates elected at the November 8, 2022 general election and the December 13, 2022 runoff election shall take the oath of office on January 6, 2023, and begin their tenure once qualified.

PART 6. The Council finds that, because of the curtailed period for a runoff election and the desire of the Council to provide an opportunity for early voting, there is a need to immediately begin required preparations for this election. Such need constitutes an emergency, and the Council declares that an emergency exists. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare.
