1 **WHEREAS**, according to the Austin Chamber, Austin ranked first among
2 the 50 largest U.S. metros based on net migration as a percent of total population in
3 2020, with a 33% increase in population in the decade ending in 2020, highlighting
4 the need for an increase in sustainable, equitable, and attainable transportation
5 options; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

6 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

7 The City Manager is directed to conduct a high-level staff review assessing
8 the feasibility of providing trail connections north of the Colorado River from
9 Pleasant Valley Road to the Colorado River Trailhead and to provide
10 recommendations, including alternatives that will increase connectivity and
11 address active transportation issues.

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

13 In the event the staff review identifies a potentially viable route for trail
14 connections, the City Manager is directed to provide the estimated cost of an in-
15 depth feasibility study of the route and the construction of the trail connections.

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

17 The City Manager is further directed to identify any funding mechanisms
18 available to urban trail projects and any impacts to existing transportation plans as
19 part of the report to Council.

2 The City Manager is directed to report findings to Council no later than June
3 2023.
