

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2022

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a Special Called Meeting on Wednesday, November 9, 2022 at Austin City Hall 301 W. Second Street, Austin, TX and via videoconference.

Mayor Pro Tem Alter called the Council Meeting to order at 11:59 a.m. Council Members Harper-Madison and Renteria joined via videoconference. Mayor Adler was off the dais.

Mayor Pro Tem Alter recessed the meeting to go into Executive Session at 11:59 a.m.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

The City Council went into Executive Session, pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, to receive advice from Legal Counsel, to discuss matters of land acquisition, litigation, and personnel matters as specifically listed on this agenda and to receive advice from Legal Counsel regarding any other item on this agenda.
