




Why do we do street preventative maintenance?


Scheduled preventative maintenance helps prolong the life of streets by protecting the surface from the effects of aging, cracking, deterioration, and water infiltration.

Preventative maintenance allows us to make safety updates, add bike lanes, and save time and taxpayer money by intervening before full reconstruction is needed.



We are always trying to improve.


Public Works is undergoing a process to discover how we can incorporate equity even more.




Annual Service Planning

Each fiscal year, the Public Works Department creates an **Annual Street Service Plan** to help achieve the following goals:

- Perform Preventive Maintenance on approximately 10% of the network each year
- Maintain 80% of street network in Fair to Excellent condition





Network Condition

Condition Grades

Blue: A (Excellent) Orange: D (Poor)

Green: B (Good) Red: F (Failed)

Yellow: C (Fair)


Austin's Street Network by Grade

Grade Meaning





- Fair: Street still preserved by preventative maintenance and more minor spot repairs.
- Poor: Street is in less than desirable condition and has an unsatisfactory ride.
- Failed: Street does not have an acceptable ride even at reduced speeds.


Lane Miles (as of FY22)

Street Inventory by Council District AS OF SEPTEMBER 2022








