

#### MISSION

#### SERVICES

- Manage, design, and inspect capital improvement projects
- Maintain the City's network of trails, roadways, and bridges once they are built
- Promote bicycle, pedestrian, safe routes to school, and urban trail programs

## STREET AND BRIDGE OPERATIONS

Manage and maintain public right-of-way infrastructure including streets, bridges, sidewalks, guardrails, trees and vegetation

- Sidewalk Services




### Why do we do street preventative maintenance?


Scheduled preventative maintenance helps **prolong the life of streets** by protecting the surface from the effects of aging, cracking, deterioration, and water infiltration.


Preventative maintenance allows us to make safety updates, add bike lanes, and save time and taxpayer money by intervening before full reconstruction is needed.

## **Influencing Factors for Pavement Life**





## **Annual Service Planning**



Each fiscal year, the Public Works Department creates an **Annual Street Service Plan** to help achieve the following goals:

- Perform Preventive Maintenance on approximately 10% of the network each year

- Maintain 80% of street network in Fair to Excellent condition







For greater transparency, we've developed a <u>GIS tool</u> that shows street maintenance for the past 10 years, plus the current Street Service Plan.





### **FY23 Plan Execution: Next Steps**
