Contract Dates

2010 -- City issues RFP

2012 - Waller Creek Boathouse completed

2012 -- Austin Rowing Club selected as vendor

2012-2017 -- initial contract term

2017-2019 -- 2-year extension

2019-2023 -- 4-year extension granted per Council resolution

February 28, 2023 -- contract expiration

Contract Description

- Vendor provides water-related recreational activities, including kayak and
 SUP rentals, free programming and scholarships for underserved youth
- Additional services include rowing memberships and lessons, event space rentals, boat rack rentals, food and beverage, fitness classes
- Partners/subcontractors include Ro Fitness, Alta's Café, and Retro Boat Rentals
- Revenue share agreement

Revenue Share

Initial contract term (through 2/28/2019)

- 3% of first \$300,000 of annual commercial gross revenue
- 10.5% of next \$900,000 of annual commercial gross revenue
- 15% of remainder of annual commercial gross revenue

Extension period

 1% of annual commercial net revenue ≤ \$80,000 plus 8% > \$80,000







Contract Extension

2021 – Project Connect plans announced

- Boathouse slated for demolition; timeline projected for 2025-2026
- RFP for new contract is postponed

2022 - Council Resolution No. 20220901-085

 Directs the City Manager to coordinate with the Austin Rowing Club to extend the concession contract up until 60 days prior to the actual scheduled demolition

2023 – Contract amendment

- Extends the contract for a period of up to 36 months, from March 1, 2023, to February 28, 2026.
- All other terms and conditions of the agreement remain the same.

Recommendation for Council Action

Recommend to Council to authorize an amendment to extend the term of the contract with Austin Rowing Club for the management and operation of Waller Creek Boathouse for a period of up to 36 months.
