Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of a cooperative contract for communications equipment and related technical support with GTS Technology Solutions, Inc. for up to four years for a total contract amount not to exceed \$550,000.

Council Committee, Boards and Commission Action:

January 9, 2023 - Recommended by the Electric Utility Commission on a 7-0 vote with Commissioners Hopkins and Bowen absent and two vacancies.

Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide communications equipment to support Austin Energy's Volt Var Optimization program, which works to reduce and conserve the amount of energy needed to serve customers without changing the quality of service. This contract will provide cellular radios to replace existing advanced metering infrastructure mesh radios and increase the reliability of communications for data acquisition and control signals.

The radios provide Austin Energy operations visibility and situational awareness by bringing information into

the Advanced Distribution Management System. This increased visibility allows operators to monitor system health and analyze readings for abnormalities to make faster, more informed decisions. The radios allow controls to be sent remotely reducing the number of truck roll outs needed to operate field devices.

The State of Texas Department of Information Resources cooperative establishes competitively bid contracts that can be utilized by the State and other government agencies through a cooperative agreement. Cooperative agreements save taxpayer dollars by leveraging the State's volume-buying power to drive down costs on hundreds of contracts through a streamlined cooperative purchasing program.
